What is it?

- Among Amazon's multitude of IoT products, the Dash Button is a small oval with a button on it that is used to replenish common household items.



- By placing these buttons in convenient places within a household, anyone can place an order for a product with one push.

How does it work?

- To use the Dash Button, simply connect the button to your wifi source, and pair it with the Amazon shopping app downloaded onto your phone.
- Then place the button in the most convenient place for your product.
- For example, a Tide button could be placed onto a washing machine, or a Doritos button inside of a pantry.



Then what?

- Then you press the button. And the button will automatically place a set “one-click” order for you to restock on whatever product it is you requested.
- As of now, Amazon has buttons for numerous products, ranging from Nerf darts to dog food.



Tech Specifications

- The Dash Button relies on WiFi and Bluetooth technology to operate.
- By connecting with a person's Amazon account and setting up preferences for the product to be ordered, the button is able to be operational within a few minutes.
- The basic design is simple, yet the Dash Button is an effective and useful product for the general population, from homeowners to college students.
