Introduction and Installation

Extensibility is a core aspect of the architecture and design of ThingWorx. Partners, third parties, and general ThingWorx users can easily add new functionality into the system, seamlessly. Extensions can be in the form of Service (function/method) Libraries, Connector Templates, Widgets, and more. This document provides installation and usage instructions for the PDF Extension.

About the PDF Extension


The PDF Extension allows you to generate a PDF file out of a specific Mashup. This resulting file will have a screenshot of that Mashup inserted on it, rendered on a specific resolution.

The PDF Extension creates a Resource called PDF Export, with a single service called CreatePDF.

Installing the PDF Extension

- **1.** From a web browser, launch ThingWorx.
- **2.** Log into ThingWorx as an administrator.

3. Go to Import/Export > Import.



- **4.** Click Choose File and select PDFExtension.zip
- 5. Click Import.

Note: If an **Import Successful** message does not display, contact your ThingWorx System Administrator.

6. Click **Yes** to refresh Composer after importing the final extension.

- Now that all of the extensions have been imported, find and open the PDFExport Resource.
- **8.** Under Entity Information, click **Services**.

- **9.** In the My Services list, next to the **CreatePDF** service, click **Test**.
- **10.** In the Initialize Test Service popup, click **Execute Service**.
- 11. Click Close.

Configuration and Usage

The extension doesn't require specific configuration after install.

Usage

The PDF Extension can be used by invoking the following service:

- CreatePDF: this service has several parameters
- Rotated90Deg: if this is set to true, then the screenshot of the mashup will be rotated 90 degrees to the left when displayed in the PDF file. Useful when wanting to print Landscape pages
- Resolution: this must be in the format x*y, e.g. 1366x768 and it controls the rendering of the page. Please use here the resolution for which the Mashup was designed for. If the resolution will be too small, then less information will be displayed.
- ThingWorxuser: user used to access the ThingWorx server. This user must have permission to run all the services and also Visibility to all involved entities from the Mashup.
- ThingWorxPassword: password for the ThingWorx user above
- OutputFileName: the name of the PDF file that will be saved on the specified Repository. An example would be Report.PDF
- ServerAddress: this is the ThingWorx server address pointing to the desired mashup. It must end in /Runtime/index.html#mashup=mashup_name. It will not work with Thingworx/Mashups/mashup_name. You can however pass url parameters.
- FileRepository: the file repository where the resulting PDF file will be saved.

Known Limitations and Compatibility

This extension was tested for compatibility with the following ThingWorx Platform version(s) and Operating System(s):

ThingWorx Platform Version	ThingWorx 7.0.1
OS	Windows 7, Service Pack 1

The extension does not require Windows.

At the moment the Extension needs free ports from 10000 to 10007.
